This internship is under exemption from Statutory Minimum Wage under the Minimum Wage Ordinance (Cap. 608). Work experience students will be required to sign and submit the Statutory declaration made by a work experience student for a period of exempt student employment and Confirmation of student status for “work experience student”. Allowance: \$100 meal and transportation allowance will be provided per working day (8 hours) for work experience students during the period of exemption from Statutory Minimum Wage.

Students may also apply for credit-bearing internships as student interns to fulfil the compulsory or elective component of their course. They will be required to sign and submit Confirmation of student status for “student intern” and arrange necessary documents with their education institutions providing the programmes. Allowance: Not applicable.
